RULES OF THE COMPETITION

1. 4 field players and one goal keeper comprises a team (5-a-side)
 2. 10 players may be nominated per team with no limit to substitutes to be used per game
 3. No off-side / back-pass rule apply.
 4. Play on small field (30 m x 20 m) with small goals.
 5. No player may turn 10 years of age in 2017. Players must born 2008 or later (**Birth certificates of all players must be on hand and need to be present should it be required**).
 6. AGE CHEATING will mean immediate disqualification on the tournament
 7. Duration of matches: 2 x 10 minutes, 2 minutes half time, 3 minutes break
 8. No player may shift from one team to another in the same group or from one group to the next group, unless allowed by tournament organiser.
 9. Teams are to be ready 5 minutes before commencement of their scheduled match at the centre line.
 10. Teams not ready at commencement of their scheduled match will forfeit the points (opposing team will receive 3 points; 2:0 result).
- Club representatives (coaches) of each club are responsible for correct game schedule as per fixtures provided.**
11. **All clubs shall have bibs on hand** in the event of clash of colour.
 12. Mode of play will be on a **double round robin** with positions to be determined by
 - Most points
 - Direct result
 - Goal difference
 - Goals scored
 - Penalties (best of five, then sudden death)
 13. Play-offs no extra time, direct penalties. (Best of 5, then sudden death)
 14. **In the event of penalties, the goalkeeper who was in the goal in the final minute of the play-off game has to be the same for the penalty shootout and may not be substituted after the final whistle of the game**
 15. Rulings of the tournament coordinator are final
 16. Goals scored by direct throw-in and/or directly out of goalkeeper hands are only valid if the ball was conformingly **touched** (not by hand) by a player (including a goalkeeper) **before the ball fully passed the goal line**. **Goals scored directly by a goalkeeper out of his hand hence do not count**. For clarity: kick-offs from the ground directly into the goal are regular goals and are valid.
 17. Boundary Line/Fair Play Zone: Coaching and Player's zone will be fenced off and no spectators and parents are allowed to enter this zone. Maximum 2 coaches per team and the substitute players are allowed in the Fair Play Zone. No spectators, no coaches, nor substitute players are allowed behind or directly adjacent to the goals / goal line. The corners are to be maintained clear by Coaches and / or substitute players. Not adhering to this rule can result in disqualification of the team.
 18. Back-pass rule: the goalkeeper is **allowed to pick up balls directly passed back** from any player of his team by any regular means (head, foot or body, but not hands)
 19. Goalkeepers are only allowed to touch the ball by hand within their demarcated area. Touching the ball outside the demarcated area leads to a direct freekick.
 20. Penalties are to be taken by the demarcated penalty spot and/or at least 8 meters from the goal line.
 21. Penalties are to be taken by any registered team player that was **on the field while the penalty was awarded**.
